The Ted DeLaney Youth Opportunity Grant is open to residents of Rockbridge County, Lexington and Buena Vista, in or between grades K-12. Exceptions may occasionally be made for younger siblings accompanying a K-12 sibling.

Girls, women, and minorities are strongly encouraged to apply.

Examples of education-related initiatives, projects, or instruction:

- After-school program registration fee.
- Summer program fees,
- Educational field trips, instructional materials, etc.

Applications should be submitted by April 30 of any given year for summer programs and by August 1 for after-school programs. Applications for other types of instruction, materials, etc. will be considered as funding permits.
